The past 2 years, God has blessed the church plant through 2 platforms. Our regular Living Water Fellowship at a nearby senior home on 2nd & 4th Wednesdays of each month serves the Chinese residents and at the same time, this ministry allows atheist volunteers to serve and learn alongside us. Our Friday life group provides Open discussions on the core values of Christianity.
